However, the Parish Council recognises the need to replace the far from adequate mobile classrooms currently in situ.</i> <i>Proposed by PC, seconded by MW. All in favour.</i>

004/01e/18 To discuss concerns regarding removal of recently fallen tree on Pinfold Green by NCC

PC reported that the stump left by NCC following the removal of the fallen tree had been removed and taken to the tip during the regular Clean-Up Group held on Sunday.

005/01e/18 To discuss concerns over damage caused to Pinfold Green by bus company

Discussion took place regarding a recent incident when a Stagecoach bus had to be towed out of deep mud after it had cut the corner on Pinfold Green and become stuck. Residents who use the bus service are concerned about bus drivers' complaints about parked cars. One resident noted that more cars are parked due to the development work on Pound Lane. Futures Housing had previously agreed that they would provide dropped curbs in order to allow residents to park in their front gardens. However, it was understood by residents that Futures Housing have now reneged on that agreement.

A discussion was had regarding yellow lines and it was noted this would be highly unlikely due to expected objections from residents and the cost to NCC Highways. Following further discussion, it was agreed that the Parish Council would write to Futures Housing to clarify the position regarding dropped curbs and would also ask Ian Boyes at NCC to do a site visit.

It was agreed that the Clean-Up Group, having done some repair work at the weekend, will try to obtain some soil to fill the area ready for re-seeding.
